

MOVING ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Many appliances and electronic items are sensitive to transit conditions such as road vibrations and climate conditions including heat, cold and humidity. These transit conditions are beyond the control of the van line.

In the course of transportation, items such as, but not limited to the following are subject to malfunctions.:

Telephones	Refrigerators
VCRs	Dryers
Televisions	Washers
Stereo Equipment	Personal Computers

CD Players

Malfunctions may occur due to uncontrollable transit conditions. Your equipment worked prior to the move, but does not operate properly after the move. The cause may not be due to the handling.

Inherent vice states that a carrier is not liable for mechanical malfunctions without direct evidence of either carrier neglect or mishandling. Road vibrations and climatic changes causing the malfunctions have been determined to be beyond the van line's control.

We recommend some precautionary measures to guard against mechanical malfunctions.

CD Players	Read your instruction manual concerning travel preparations.

Perform a complete back up of your software.

Use original carton for your computer.

Make use of lockdowns.

Pack your system in original cartons.
